Pixie Hat & Scarf *(intermediate)*

MEASUREMENTS

Hat

Fits head (approx) 56 cms/22 ins

Scarf

Width (approx) 11 cms/4 ins

Length 150 cms/60 ins

CRAFTWORKS YARN **Blink Plain or Blink Print**

3 x 50g balls for **Hat**

3 x 50g balls for **Scarf**

NEEDLES

A pair 5.50mm (US 9), (UK 5) Knitting Needles
or size that gives correct tension/gauge.

MATERIALS

A Yarn Needle.

Matching plain yarn for sewing seam.

TENSION/GAUGE

15 sts and 26 rows to 10 cms/4 ins over stocking st, using 5.50mm (US 9), (UK 5) Knitting Needles.

Note - Correct tension/gauge is essential for a successful handknit.

ABBREVIATIONS

St/s - stitch/es, **K** - Knit, **P** - Purl, **stocking st** - 1 row K, 1 row P, **garter st** - every row knit, **RS** - right side, **WS** - wrong side, **sl** - slip, **psso** - pass slipped stitch over, **K2tog** - knit 2 sts together, **P2tog** - purl 2 sts together, **beg** - begin/ning, **rep** - repeat, **rem** - remain/ning.

CREATE

Hat

Using 5.50mm (US 9), (UK 5) Needles, cast on 76 sts.

Work in stocking st until work measures 15 cms/6 ins from beg, ending with a purl row.

Tie a coloured marker at each end of last row.

Next row - K2tog, knit to last 2 sts, K2tog.

Next row - P2tog, purl to last 2 sts, P2tog.

Rep last 2 rows until 2 sts rem.

Next row - P2tog. Fasten off.

Tassels (make 3)

Using 5.50mm (US 9), (UK 5) Needles, cast on 12 sts.

Work in stocking st until work measures 7 cms/3 ins from beg, ending with a purl row.

Next row - Cast/bind off 5 sts.

Fasten off the st on right hand needle and slip rem sts on left hand needle off the needle. Unravel these sts all the way down to the cast on edge.

FINISHING

DO NOT PRESS. Using yarn needle, darn in ends. Fold hat in half and using matching plain yarn and back-stitch, join side edges together, from coloured markers to the point of hat. Cut 12 strands of yarn, each strand 80 cms/32 ins long. Fold tassels in half and sew the cast on and cast (bind) off edges together. Gather the side opposite the laddered edges and pull tightly to form tassel head. Fill this section with scraps of yarn. Gather the other side edge of knitting and secure by wrapping yarn around the bottom of the head several times. Make the other tassel in the same manner. Secure one tassel to the point of the hat. Attach the 6 long strands of yarn to each corner of the cast on edge of the hat (earflaps) and plait. Attach a tassel to each plait.

CREATE

Scarf

Using 5.50mm (US 9), (UK 5) Needles, cast on 17 sts.

Knit in garter st (1st row is WS) until work measures 150 cms/60 ins from beg, working last row on WS.

Cast/bind off loosely knitways.

FINISHING

DO NOT PRESS. Using yarn needle, darn in ends. If desired, attach a fringe to each end of scarf with remaining yarn.
