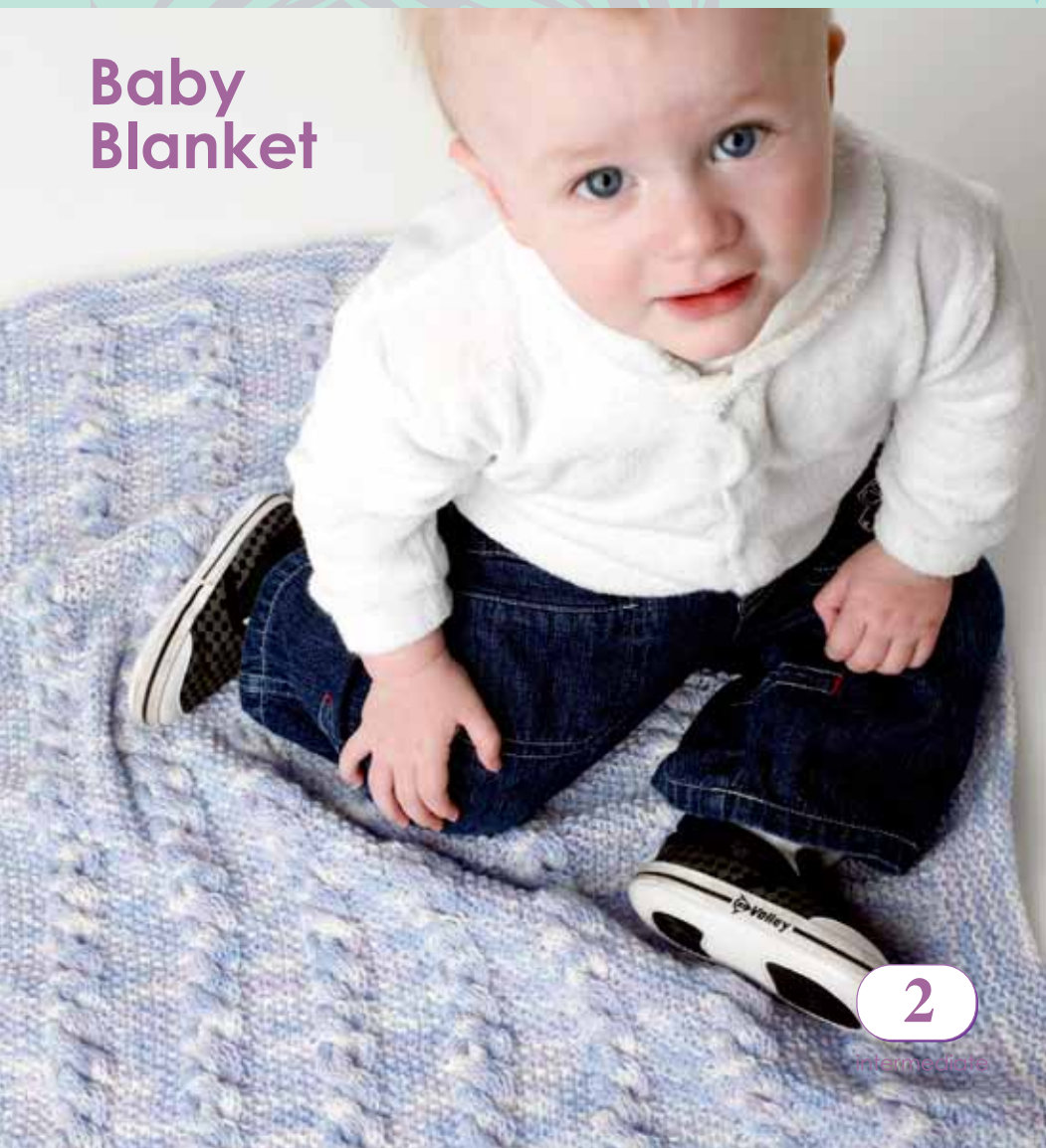

# Baby Blanket *(intermediate)*

## MEASUREMENTS

Width (approx) 50 cms/20 ins  
Length (approx) 80 cms/32 ins

## CRAFTWORKS YARN BABY SHINY

**PLAIN OR PRINT** 5 x 50g balls

## NEEDLES

A pair 4.00mm (US 6), (UK 8) Knitting Needles  
**or size that gives correct tension/gauge.**

## MATERIALS

A Yarn Needle; A Cable Needle.

## TENSION/GAUGE

**20 sts and 37 rows to 10 cm/4 ins over moss st, using 4.00mm (US 6), (UK 8) Knitting Needles.**

**Note - Correct tension/gauge is essential for a successful handknit.**

## ABBREVIATIONS

**St/s** - stitch/es, **K** - Knit, **P** - Purl, **WS** - wrong side, **RS** - right side, **garter st** - every row knit, **inc** - increase, **rep** - repeat, **beg** - begin/ning, **patt** - pattern, **cont** - continue, **sl** - slip, **K2tog** - knit 2 sts together, **pssso** - pass slipped st over.

## SPECIAL ABBREVIATION

**Cable** - slip next 4 sts onto cable needle and leave at front of work, K4, then K4 from cable needle.

## CREATE

### Blanket

Using 4.00mm (US 6), (UK 8) Needles, cast on 91 sts.

Knit 12 rows garter st (1st row is WS).

**13th row** - K7, \* K1, inc once in each of next 3 sts, K8, rep from \* to end = 112 sts.

**Beg patt - 1st row** (RS) - K1, (P1, K1) 3 times, \* K9, (P1, K1) 3 times, rep from \* to end.

**2nd row** - K1, (P1, K1) 3 times, \* P8, K1, (P1, K1) 3 times, rep from \* to end.

**3rd row** - K1, (P1, K1) 3 times, \* **Cable**, K1, (P1, K1) 3 times, rep from \* to end.

**4th row** - As 2nd row.

Rep 1st and 2nd rows once.

Last 6 rows form patt.

Cont in patt until work measures approx 77 cms/31 ins from beg, ending with a 4th patt row.

**Next row** - Moss 7, \* K1, sl 1, K2tog, pssso, K2tog, K2, moss 7, rep from \* to end = 91 sts.

Knit 13 rows garter st. Cast/bind off loosely knitways.

## Side Edgings

With RS facing and using 4.00mm needles, knit up 160 sts evenly along one side edge of Blanket.

Knit 12 rows garter st.

Cast/bind off loosely knitways.

Rep along other side edge of Blanket.

## FINISHING

**DO NOT PRESS.** Using yarn needle, darn in ends.
