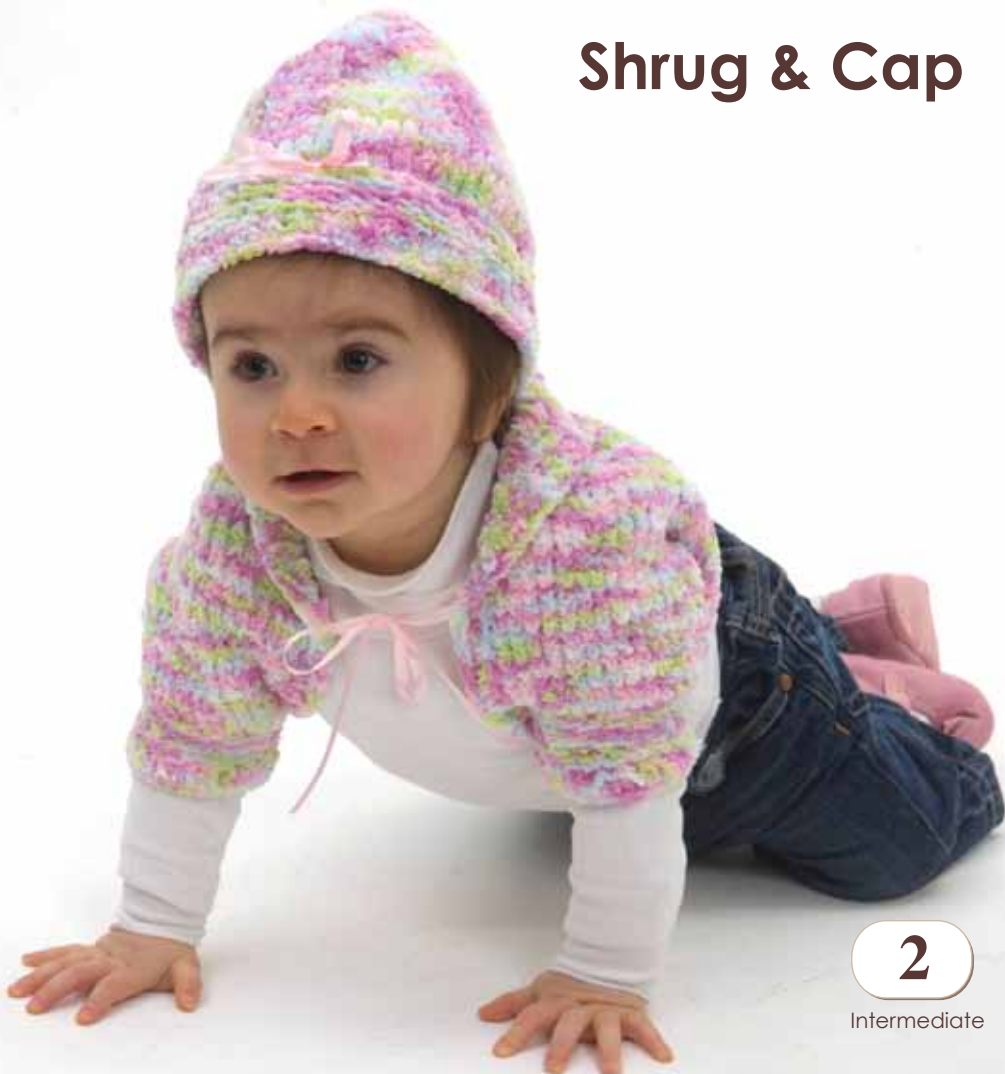

Shrug & Cap

Intermediate

Shrug & Cap *(intermediate)*

MEASUREMENTS

Shrug size: 3 (6 - 9 - 12) months

Fits underarm

40 (45 - 47 - 50) cms / 16 (18 - 19 - 20) ins

To measure

46 (52 - 54 - 58) cms / 18½ (21 - 21½ - 23) ins

Length (approx)

50 (56 - 59 - 62) cms / 19 (22 - 23 - 24) ins

Cap size: 3 (6 - 9 - 12) months

Fits head

40 (45 - 47 - 48) cms / 16 (18 - 19 - 19½) ins

CRAFTWORKS YARN CHENILLE

PLAIN OR PRINT

Shrug 2 (2 - 3 - 3)

Cap 1 (1 - 1 - 1)

NEEDLES

A pair 5.00mm (US 8), (UK 6) Knitting Needles
or size that give correct tension (gauge).

MATERIALS

A Yarn Needle. A 70 cm (28 in) length of 15 mm (3/4 in) wide ribbon. Matching plain yarn for sewing seams.

TENSION (GAUGE)

12 sts and 25 rows to 10 cm (4 ins) over stocking st, using 5.00mm (US 8), (UK 6) Knitting Needles .

Note - Correct tension (gauge) is essential for a successful handknit.

ABBREVIATIONS

St/s - stitch/es, **K** - Knit, **P** - Purl, **stocking st** - 1 row knit, 1 row purl, **RS** - right side, **WS** - wrong side, **garter st** - every row knit, **K2tog** - knit 2 sts together, **P2tog** - purl 2 sts together, **dec** - knit or purl 2 sts together, **rep** - repeat, **rem** - remain/ing, **cont** = continue, **beg** - begin/ beginning, **fol** - following, **alt** - alternate.

CREATE

Shrug (worked in one piece)

Beg at cuff - Using 5.00mm (US 8), (UK 6) Needles, cast on 30 (34-34-36) sts **very loosely**.

Work 2 rows stocking st.

Next row - * K2tog, rep from * to end = 15 (17-17-18) sts.

Knit 15 rows garter st.

Next row - K1 (2-1-1), inc once in each st to last 2 (3-2-2) sts, K2 (3-2-2) = 27 (29-31-33) sts.

Cont in stocking st, beg with a purl row, until work measures 43.5 (49.5-52.5-55.5) cm, [17 ½ (20-21-22) ins], from beg, ending with a knit row.

Next row - P1 (2-1-1), * P2tog, rep from * to last 2 (3-2-2) sts, P2 (3-2-2) = 15 (17-17-18) sts.

Knit 15 rows garter st.

Next row - Inc once in each st to end = 30 (34-34-36) sts.

Work 2 rows stocking st, beg with a knit row. Cast (bind) off **very loosely**.

Edging

Using yarn needle and back-stitch, join sleeve seams for 8 cm, (3 ins), from lower edges of cuffs. With RS facing, using 5.00mm (US 8), (UK 6) Needles, knit up 41 (49-53-55) sts evenly along one edge.

Next row - Knit to end.

Next row - Inc once in each st to end = 82 (98-106-110) sts.

Next row - Purl to end.

Cast (bind) off **very loosely**.

Rep along other edge.

FINISHING

DO NOT PRESS. Using yarn needle, darn in ends. Attach ribbon to front edges as pictured and tie in a bow.

Cap

Using 5.00mm (US 8), (UK 6) Needles, cast on 84 (94-104-114) sts **very loosely**.

Work 2 rows stocking st.

Next row - * K2tog, rep from * to end = 42 (47-52-57) sts

Knit 9 rows garter st.

Work in stocking st, beg with a knit row, until work measures 10 (11-12-13) cm, [4 (4 ½-5-5 ½) ins], from beg, ending with a purl row.

Shape crown - 1st row - K2, * K6 (7-8-9), K2tog, rep from * to end = 37 (42-47-52) sts.

Work 3 rows stocking st, beg with a purl row.

5th row - K2, * K5 (6-7-8), K2tog, rep from * to end = 32 (37-42-47) sts.

6th and foll alt rows - Purl.

7th row - K2, * K4 (5-6-7), K2tog, from * to end = 27 (32-37-42) sts

9th row - K2, * K3 (4-5-6), K2tog, rep from * to end = 22 (27-32-37) sts.

Keeping decreasing correct, work a further 5 (7-9-11) rows, working 1 less st between decreasing (as before) = 12 sts.

Next row - * K2tog, rep from * to end = 6 sts.

Cast (bind) off.

FINISHING

DO NOT PRESS. Using yarn needle, darn in ends. Using back-stitch and matching plain yarn, join centre back and top seam.
